IMPORTANT NOTICE. In order to receive the **SCHOOL GROUP DISCOUNT RATE**, your school and/or learning institution must be a registered and/or considered a legal and viable **SCHOOL** or **HOME SCHOOL** organization.

To receive your discounted school group admission rate. Reservations must be received, in writing or online, at least two (2) weeks in advance. The discount on regular priced admission will apply for a group of 20 or more paying people. All school groups with children under the age of 13 must have adult supervision with a ratio of one adult for every 10 children.

Reservation requests: To request a reservation time for your school group, schedule your trip under the PLAN YOUR VISIT section online at montgomeryzoo.com, or complete the School Group Reservation form and mail or fax to (334) 625-4916.

Do not send money with the request form. Payment is due at the time of your group's arrival at the Zoo or Museum admission window. The group must enter the Zoo or Museum together and one person must pay for the entire group. Extra adults, chaperones and/or paying individuals (all individuals not included on your group reservation totals) will be charged full admission prices. A Reservation Confirmation will be sent to you confirming either your first or second choice. Based on availability, one of the dates you selected will be assigned by Zoo or Museum personnel.

Parents, chaperones, friends and family members not included in the group reservation will have to pay regular admission rather than the discounted rate. In order for parents, chaperones, friends, family members to receive the discounted admission rate, they **MUST BE INCLUDED** in the group reservation and payment.

Separate payments are required for zoo/museum admission and Overlook Café food purchases. Rides, encounters and attractions should be included with your zoo and/or museum admission. Checks for zoo should be written to the MONTGOMERY ZOO. Checks for food and lunch orders should be made out to SOUTHERN FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT.

Avoid the wait when checking in at the Zoo: Group leaders may pay for and pick up wristbands and/or attraction ride tickets prior to their group's scheduled visit date. Pay with a credit card while making online reservations or pay at the zoo prior to the group's scheduled visit date. Then on the scheduled visit date, you and your group can bypass the lines waiting for wristbands and tickets.

Cancellation Policy: Call the Zoo/Museum office at (334) 625-4900 prior to the date of your visit to cancel or change your reservations. Failure to cancel your reservations with adequate notice will make you liable for the cost of program fees, tour fees, shelter rentals and/or food items ordered, etc. You may cancel your group meals up to 24 hours before scheduled arrival to the Zoo/Museum. Any cancellations made within the 24 hour window will be charged in full for your group meals unless the cancellation is due to a weather related event.

School group tax exemption: If you qualify for tax exemption, please make sure that you provide your school/organization's TAX ID NUMBER and PAPERWORK to SOUTHERN FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT for all food and lunch orders.

Picnics and outside food: Picnics and outside food are allowed in all areas of the Zoo with the exception of the Overlook. Guests and visitors may have picnic lunches and snacks at the various shelters, grassy areas, benches, tent areas and the playground area. No cup lids and/or straws will be allowed for the protection of our animals. We do ask all of your guests to clean up their picnic areas when you are done to keep our Zoo as clean as you found it.

Shelter rentals: Shelters are available for rental. Please contact the Zoo to reserve. Playground area: \$65 for 3 hours. Front gate area: \$65 for three hours. Time slots available for both: 9am - noon and 1pm - 4pm. Shelters must be reserved in advance.

Concessions: Zoo and Museum Gift shops. A variety of snacks, candy, sodas and water are available at the both gift shops. Overlook Cafe. A variety of snacks, refreshments, drinks, meals, slushies, ice cream and much more are available at the Overlook Cafe. No food or drinks allowed in the Mann Museum.

Zoo Wildlife Adventures, Rides and Encounters. All rides and encounters close at 4:30pm.

Train: The Montgomery Zoo's miniature train runs daily, 9am - 4:30pm. Tickets are \$3 per person.

Giraffe Encounter Post: Open daily, 10am - 4:30pm. Tickets are \$3 per person.

Zoofari Skylift Rides: Open daily, 10am - 4:30pm. Tickets are \$5. All riders must be 42 inches tall.

Parakeet Cove Feed Sticks: Cove open daily, 10am - 4:30pm, Feeding sticks are \$2 per stick.

Petting Zoo Animal Feed Bags: Petting Zoo open daily, 10am - 4:30pm, Feed bags are \$2 per bag.

Feeding Stations: Feeding stations are located at the River Otter exhibit and Asian Koi Fish pond. Feed is 50 cents.

Stingray Bay: Located adjacent to the Mann Museum. Open daily, 10am - 4:30pm. Entry to exhibit is FREE with paid zoo admission. \$3 per person to feed stingrays.

Elephant Keeper Talk: 10:30am daily, free with paid admission | **Lion Keeper Talk:** 1pm daily, free with paid admission
